Dear secondary home owners,

The Tourist Office has the pleasure of contacting you concerning **the Summer 2022 VIP Pass**. As mentioned in the letter sent to you in December 2021, this year, we are not issuing new VIP Passes as you can reuse the passes you received last summer.

To use your VIP Pass this summer, please read the instructions on the back of this letter.

You can, if you wish, change the beneficiary holders of your VIP Passes. In this case, please follow the following steps:

- Send us a modification request to info@latzoumaz.ch
- Your email must contain the following information: name of the owner entitled to the VIP Pass (if not you) and the pass numbers to be changed.
- We will send you your VIP Passes by post to the same billing address as for the tourist taxes. It is also possible, on request, to pick them up directly on site at the tourist office.
- The deadline for requesting modifications is 30 June 2022. After this deadline, no modifications can be made.

## **Pass reactivation**

In order to benefit from the new range of services valid during the summer of 2022, you must reactivate your VIP Pass today. To do this, you just have to proceed in the <u>same way as last year</u>. Please refer to the procedure in the appendix.

Once activated, your pass is valid until the end of October 2022.

At the end of the season, please keep your passes in a safe place as you will be able to use them again for next summer.

Please note that the passes remain personal, nominative and therefore non-transferable throughout the season, and that IN CASE OF LOST OR FORGOTTEN PASSES, YOU WILL BE CHARGED CHF 10 PER NEW PASS.
